TOPIC: Charles Carroll and His Contributions for the Victory at Yorktown



The Homewood property was purchased in 1800 by Charles Carroll, signer of the Declaration of Independence, as a wedding present for his only son Charles and his bride Harriet Chew of Philadelphia. The younger Charles designed and guided the construction of this outstanding federal style country house. The Homewood was completed in 1805 and is listed in the National Register of Historic places. The 130 acres farm originally had a dozen service buildings.
