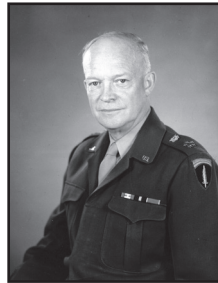


Dwight D. Eisenhower Compatriot Grave Marking
